1. These results have been prepared in accordance with the Ind AS notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015. These results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 11.02.2022

2. Segment Reporting: Managing Director & CEO of the Company has been identified as the Chief Operating Decision Makers (CODM) as defined by IND AS 108 "Operating Segments". The Company operates in one segment only i.e. "Information Technology Services". The CODM evaluates performance of the Company based on revenue and operating income from the above segment. Accordingly, segment reporting has not been separately disclosed.

3. Figures for the previous year have been regrouped/rearranged wherever necessary to correspond with current period figures.

4. Estimation uncertainty relating to COVID-19 outbreak: The Company has considered internal and certain external sources of information including economic forecasts and industry reports up to the date of approval of the financial statements in determining the impact on various elements of its financial statements. The Company has used the principles of prudence in applying judgments, estimates and assumptions including sensitivity analysis and based on the current estimates, the Company expects to fully recover the carrying amount of trade receivables including unbilled receivables, goodwill, intangible assets and investments. The eventual outcome of impact of the global health pandemic may be different from those estimated as on the date of approval of these financial statements.

5. The new code on Social Security, 2020, has been enacted which would impact the contributions by the Company towards Provident Fund and Gratuity. The effective date from which the changes are applicable are yet to be notified. The Ministry of Labour and Employment (Ministry) has released draft rules for the Code on November, 13, 2020 and has invited suggestions from stakeholders which are under active consideration by the Ministry. The Company will complete its evaluation and will give appropriate impact in its standalone financial results in the period in which the Code becomes effective and the related rules are published.



1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results of **M/s.CG-VAK Software and Exports Limited**("the Company")('the Holding Company') and its subsidiary M/S. CG-VAK Software USA Inc,(the Holding Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group"), for the Quarter ended **December 31, 2021**("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, including relevant circulars issued by the SEBI from time to time.

2. This Statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting"("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the statement based on our review.

3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity', issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of the Company's personnel responsible for financial and accounting matters and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33(8) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.

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4. The interim financial results of the subsidiary, M/s.CG-VAK software USA Inc., included in the statement reflects total assets of Rs.1,378.55 Lakhs as at December 31,2021, total Income of Rs. 419.34 lacs for the quarter ended 31st December 2021 and Rs1065.27 lakhs for the period 01-04-2021 to 31-12-2021, total net profit of Rs.6.52 Lakhs for the quarter ended December 31,2021 and Rs10.66 lakhs for the period 01-04-2021 to 31-12-2021. The interim financial results of the subsidiary, M/s.CG-VAK software USA Inc., as considered in the consolidated unaudited financial results have been prepared by the company's management in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in USA. The company's management has converted the financial results and other financial information of the said subsidiary from the accounting principles generally accepted in USA to the accounting principles generally accepted in India' The unaudited financial results and other financial information for the foreign subsidiary, M/s CG-VAK software USA Inc., are not required to be audited under the relevant foreign laws. We have performed the procedures as stated in paragraph 3 above.

5. Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results prepared in accordance with the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
